Jordan, CEO and founder of SCOTTeVEST, because I was intrigued by what he advertised as a "wired" vest that looked in the photos less like the traditional concealment vest. I requested their Classic in a slate gray color. My first modeling inspired the comment, "I like it better than any other vest you've got," from my wife. That can only be a plus when it comes to wardrobe selection!

My plan was to write about the SCOTTeVEST for concealment, which it did admirably. I had it all written up and then something came up. Now don't get me wrong, the Classic SCOTTeVEST works just fine. It hangs well and sweeps back during the draw just fine.

However, I recently made a seven-day trip to Germany, which meant about 13 hours in transit, one way, with two changes of planes, to attend the IWA (Europe's version of the SHOT Show).
