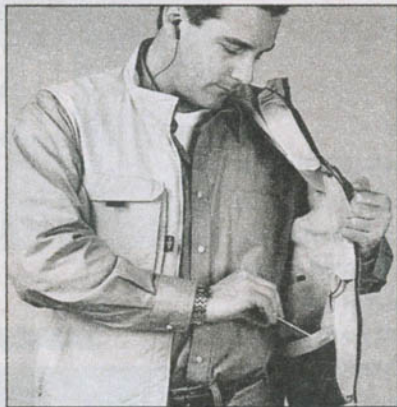

Clothing is finally catching up to the Digital Revolution with the SCOTT eVEST (about \$100; www.scottevest.com). Similar to a fisherman's vest, though more stylish, the eVEST contains 15 pockets for electronic gizmos—cell phone, pocket music player, handheld computer, pager, etc.—as well as keys, business cards, tickets, even beverages. For students, photographers and travelers, it's ideal for speeding through airport security: Simply slip off the vest and pass it through the X-ray machine. The eVEST's coolest feature is its Personal Area Network, a series of conduits hidden in the fabric that connect the various pockets to the collar of the vest: Thread your wires through them, and you can wear headphones and headsets without getting tangled up.
